The following tasks were undertaken by WHISPER volunteers:

- Problem: Transportation for physician appointments  
Resolution: Provided transportation (multiple times)
- Problem: Homebound/ill residents – meal deliveries instituted  
Resolution: Delivered meals (multiple times)
- Problem: Home repairs  
Resolution: cleaned house for senior, unclogged drain; took trash to recycle, needed assistance with cable for TWC, installation of new sump pump hose
- Problem: Yard/Lawn care  
Resolution: leaf pick up, snow removal (driveway), snow shoveled from back door, getting car out of driveway
- Problem: Resident needed transportation to vote  
Resolution: Provided resident transportation to polls
- Problem: Resident going through divorce; needed help with phone call to court  
Resolution: Assisted resident with court issue
- Problem: Resident needed computer help to file paperwork related to bankruptcy.  
Resolution: Assisted resident with paperwork.
- Problem: Resident had accumulated 10 bags of documents to shred  
Resolution: Took resident's bags and recycled with our shred day shredding
- Problem: Resident wanted photo CD of her valuables  
Resolution: Photos were taken and put on CD of her valuables for security purposes.
