### **Procedure for Proposed Revisions:**

1. 2 Members will be nominated to prepare proposed revisions approved by a majority vote of the Commission during discussions of each Article. The 2 members will be responsible for presenting the written proposed revisions at the next meeting and will also be charged with reviewing the remainder of the Charter to confirm that the changes do not conflict with any other provision of the Charter (or suggesting appropriate revisions).

2. Written Copies of the Proposed Revisions will be presented and reviewed under "Old Business" at the following meeting. Revisions approved by a majority of the Commission will be made by the drafters for submission at the following Meeting.

3. Revised Written Copies of the Proposed Revisions will be presented and reviewed under Old Business at the next Meeting. If satisfactory to a majority, the Proposed Revisions will be placed on the June 1, 2015 Agenda for final discussion or disposed with as determined by the Commission.

Please review the applicable Articles noted above prior to each meeting. Prior to the June 1 and June 15 meetings, please review all proposed changes to permit a thorough discussion of each proposed revision in preparation of the ballot vote for each proposed revision.
