ORDINANCE NO. 2015-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE BID OF R. W. SIDLEY FOR A NEW 2016 SINGLE AXLE DUMP TRUCK & CHASSIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on April 23, 2015, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids to secure a new service vehicle namely the cab and chassis; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of the Willoughby Hills has accepted the recommendation of the Mayor/Service Director to purchase a **New, Never Used Model 2016 Heavy Duty Single Axle Dump Truck Chassis** pursuant to the bid submitted by R. W. Sidley, Inc. of 7123 Madison Road, P. O. Box 10, Thompson, Ohio 44086, consisting of twenty-four (24) pages, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A"; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:


SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with R. W. Sidley, Inc. of 7123 Madison Road, P. O. Box 10, Thompson, Ohio 44086 for the purchase of a **New, Never Used Model 2016 Heavy Duty Single Axle Dump Truck Chassis** for a price **not to exceed \$108, 230.00** pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the bid submitted by R. W. Sidley, Inc., attached hereto as the **Exhibit "A"**, consisting of twenty-four (24) pages and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Service Department; to wit: the Mayor/Safety Director requested that this Ordinance become effective immediately due to the lengthy expected delivery date of 100 to 120 working days after receipt of the order; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


