

CORN FEST MEETING OF 5/12/14  
MINUTES

Meeting had twelve attendees.

Gloria Majeski presented the flyer with the plans for the June and August 2014 concerts at the Gazebo (attached). Coordination of Committee members was discussed concerning 50/50 raffle, parking, corn cooking (August concert only), corn payment (August concert only). All were welcomed to once again volunteer, though this year's event is on a much smaller scale than Corn Fest had been in the past.

Rain plan would be to move all activities to the O'Ryan Room. Denise Edwards confirmed that it had been set aside accordingly.

Gloria will work with Dave Reichelt soon to update website to this year's plans and layout for vendors and power/sound needs.

Ray Somich presented the plans for the July 19 concert. Details still pending some of the requirements by DDR Management. Working with merchants to provide food vending, sidewalk shopping and giveaways. Chris Hallum said they would continue to try to negotiate with DDR to be able to make it affordable for an outside vendor to have a food booth. Ray waiting to hear back from Driven, currently committed to another venue, but may be able to move the date. If not, DJ will be used for stage music. Denise will contact others to do Zumba, Irish Dance, etc. The car show would be in conjunction with Baker's Square. Gloria can provide names and would be happy to contact previous car show attendees from previous Corn Fests with a flyer to encourage participation. This would not be a judged show, but rather a "show and shine" type of show. Ray will work on overview map of how he envisions setup. Fireworks will be aerial show – last year of City's commitment to Mad Bombers – behind the plaza. Site has already been reviewed by Fire Chief and is a safe endeavor. Rain date for fireworks will be the August concert on 8/20/14. Ray asked for the Committee's "blessing" to proceed with his plans to get it off of the ground on the west end. We assured him we welcome his plans and will help in any way he may need it. Willoughby Western Lake County will be advertising the event for us.
