The following tasks were undertaken by WHISPER volunteers:

- Problem: Transportation for physician appointments
Resolution: Provided transportation (multiple times)
- Problem: Homebound/ill residents – meal deliveries instituted
Resolution: Delivered meals (multiple times)
- Problem: Home repairs
Resolution: removed bird's nest from outside light, repaired broken lift chair, took trash out weekly due to resident with broken leg, cleaned house with family of deceased resident, provided computer repair for resident, and cleaned house for senior
- Problem: Yard/Lawn care
Resolution: hauled away branches, did tree trimming, weeded flower bed
- Problem: Resident needed papers taken to recycle.
