

Home-Delivered Groceries for Senior Households



How does the program work?

Laketrans will distribute pre-assembled bags of groceries to seniors in need. Groceries will be dropped at your door on Tuesday or Thursday. Delivery drivers will NOT enter the home but will knock to ensure you receive your items. Delivery day will depend on when your request is received. This is a FREE program thanks to funds from the Board of Lake County Commissioners Senior Services Levy and the United Way Lake County Relief Fund but donations are accepted and appreciated.

What items will be in the grocery bag?

Bags will be assembled based on what items are in stock and available but may include items such as fresh fruits/vegetables, rice, bread, milk, and more. The value of each bag is approximately \$25.

Do I qualify?

- Age 60+
- Live in Lake County
- Unable to get out to grocery shop and do not have assistance with shopping

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

1. Dial **2-1-1** Mon - Sun 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM **OR** call the Council on Aging at **440-205-8111** Mon - Fri 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM.

Requests must be received by 2PM Monday for Tuesday delivery or 2PM Wednesday for Thursday delivery.

2. **Complete a quick questionnaire over the phone.**

When you need more groceries, just give us a call. You may receive grocery items one time each week.
