## **LAKE COUNTY SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEM (STS) OPERATION & MAINTENANCE PROGRAM PUBLIC MEETING SCHEDULE**

Lake County General Health District will be holding public meetings to discuss its Sewage Treatment System (STS) Operation & Maintenance Program. State of Ohio requires that all Boards of Health develop a program to ensure that all sewage treatment systems owners properly maintain and operate their septic systems. All homeowners with septic systems will now be required to obtain an operational permit. Meetings are open to all residents of Lake County that may be affected by the Operation & Maintenance Program.
