Sealed bids will be received by the Mayor at his Office in the City Hall, 35405 Chardon Road, Willoughby Hills, Ohio until 11:00 A.M., local time on Thursday, February 26, 2015 and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following:

- (1) LAMPLIGHT LANE CULVERT REPLACEMENT**
- (2) KNECHT-O'BRIEN CHANNEL RESTORATION**

Copies of bidding and contract documents are on file at Willoughby Hills City Hall, 35405 Chardon Road, Willoughby Hills, Ohio where they are available for inspection. These documents may be obtained at City Hall at a cost of \$40.00 per booklet for each prospective bidder. Bidding and contract documents cannot be mailed. Separate bids shall be submitted, if bidding on all projects.

Each proposal must be signed and shall be submitted on the forms provided, must contain the full names of the party or parties making the same and all persons interested therein, and must be accompanied by a bid bond for 100% of the Bid amount or a certified check drawn upon a solvent bank made unconditionally payable to the City of Willoughby Hills in amount of equal to not less than 10% of the Bid amount submitted by the bidder. The character and amount of the Bid Performance Bonds are also stated in the Instruction to Bidders.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after scheduled closing date for receipt of bids.
