## ORDINANCE NO 2020-02-AMENDED

---

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 2019-69 TO COMPLY WITH STATE BUDGETARY LAWS REQUIRING MUNICIPALITIES TO MAINTAIN POSITIVE ACCOUNT BALANCES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR BY PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF COMPUTER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE NECESSARY TO UPGRADE THE CITY'S COMPUTER NETWORK OPERATING SYSTEM TO WINDOWS 10 AND REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION.**

**WHEREAS**, Microsoft Corporation has announced that it will no longer provide support or updates for the Windows Version 7 Operating System, leaving that software vulnerable to security risks; and

**WHEREAS**, Windows Version 7 is the City's current computer network primary operating system; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the City's computers are not capable of running on Windows Version 10, Microsoft's current Operating System, making that hardware obsolete, and

**WHEREAS**, in a letter dated January 2, 2020, the Law Enforcement Automated Data Systems ("LEADS") notified the Police Department that the City must upgrade its network software to Windows Version 10 in order to continue to be permitted to access the LEADS system; and

**WHEREAS**, the attached "Schedule of 2020 Temporary Appropriation – Revision No. 1" revises the 2020 appropriation of the Capital Improvement Fund No. 420 to provide funding necessary for the acquisition of computer hardware capable of running Windows Version 10 for use by all City departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2019-69 is hereby amended to provide funding for the acquisition of computers for use by all City departments by increasing the appropriation of the Capital Improvement Fund No. 420 by THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000), from NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$9,500) TO THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$39,500), to provide funding for the acquisition of computer hardware and software necessary to upgrade the City's computer network to operate on Windows Version 10.

**SECTION 2.** The abovementioned sum, as reflected in the "**Schedule of 2020 Temporary Appropriations – Revision No. 01**", prepared January 3, 2020, marked as the "**Exhibit A**", attached

hereto, consisting of five (5) pages and incorporated herein by reference, be and hereby is set aside and appropriated hereafter.

**SECTION 3.** All monies in the Trust & Agency Funds Accounts are hereby deemed appropriated for their intended purposes.


**SECTION 4.** All expenditures within the fiscal year ending December 3, 2020, shall be made in accordance with the code accounts hereinabove set forth and shall be made within the appropriations herein provided. "Appropriation" as used means the total amount appropriated for the individual fund. Notwithstanding the financial detail herein presented, the Mayor or the Finance Director is authorized to transfer budgeted amounts within each fund provided that the total amount appropriated for the fund is not exceeded.

**SECTION 5.** The City Finance Director be and is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrants against the appropriations set forth upon presentation of proper vouchers.

**SECTION 6.** All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that results in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills


