## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-21

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2020-05 TO INCLUDE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL'S (NOPEC) SPECIFIC REQUIREMENT FOR EXECUTION OF GRANT AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR, REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on January 23, 2020, Council passed Ordinance 2020-05, authorizing all actions necessary to accept Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) Energized Community Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2020, Road Superintendent Grubiss provided the complete list of quotes received, along with his recommendations for the preferred vendors to proceed with Phase III of the NOPEC Energized Community Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2020, NOPEC received the electronic submission of Ordinance 2020-05 and the Road Superintendent's recommendations for Phase III; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2020, Jessica Chiano, NOPEC Loan and Grant Associate advised Gloria Majeski, Executive Assistant to the Mayor via email (EXHIBIT 1), that the legislation "does not include any information on who is authorized to enter into the grant agreement" and recommended that there be a line added to the ordinance to indicate that Council "authorizes the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant funds."

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:***

**SECTION 1.** Council hereby amends Ordinance 2020-05 to include that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant funds.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and they are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance, specifically Ordinance No. 2008-1, Ordinance No. 2017-65-As Amended, and Ordinance No. 2019-4.

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it allows the City to continue with the implementation of energy efficiency or energy infrastructure projects within the City Hall complex and Fire Department; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
