ORDINANCE NO. 2020-40-AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REAPPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER J. COLLINS AS POLICE CHIEF OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT, ESTABLISHING HIS TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT, INCLUDING RATE OF PAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.2 of the Charter of the City of Willoughby Hills, the Mayor, with the confirmation of the Council, shall appoint a Police Chief to act as the head of the Willoughby Hills Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Chief Christopher J. Collins has retired as Police Chief from the City of Willoughby Hills Police Department effective June 20, 2020 and it is detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the City of Willoughby Hills to be without a Police Chief during the process of filling said position on a permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that the reappointment of Christopher J. Collins as Police Chief of the City of Willoughby Hills is necessary to ensure the continued and uninterrupted health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Willoughby Hills and the Council desires to confirm the reappointment of Christopher J. Collins as Police Chief for an additional limited period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to establish the terms and conditions of employment for the reappointment of Christopher J. Collins as Police Chief of the City of Willoughby Hills Police Department, together with the rate of pay for said position, for a period not to exceed ten (10) months; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills hereby reappoints Christopher J. Collins to the position of Police Chief of the City of Willoughby Hills Police Department, for a time frame not to exceed ten (10) months, commencing July 1, 2020.

SECTION 2. That the aforesaid and reappointed Police Chief shall be vested with and shall assume the police responsibilities and essential job functions in furtherance of the City's essential law enforcement and administrative functions.

SECTION 3. The reappointed Police Chief shall be paid compensation for the period beginning July 1, 2020, at the rate of \$8,035.00 per monthly pay.


SECTION 4. The reappointed Police Chief shall further be entitled to the additional benefits set forth in Chapter 157 of the Codified Ordinances determined and based upon his reappointment date as a new employee of July 1, 2020.

SECTION 5. That said reappointed Police Chief shall respond to the inquiry of Council regarding the services of his Department and such matters that would come within his Department's responsibilities.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills and further, provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


