ORDINANCE NO. 2020-44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2020-15 TO COMPLY WITH STATE BUDGETARY LAWS REQUIRING MUNICIPALITIES TO MAINTAIN POSITIVE ACCOUNT BALANCES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR BY PROVIDING FOR 2020 OPERATING BUDGET REVISIONS SPECIFICALLY FOR THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND SPECIAL REVENUE FUND AND REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION.

WHEREAS, the Members of Council are in receipt of the Interoffice Memo from Finance Director Brichacek dated July 17, 2020 consisting of two (2) pages, attached hereto as the “**Exhibit B**” and referenced herein, said memorandum is a request for an increase in the appropriation of the Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund No. 204; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2020 the on June 29, 2020 the City received \$532,321.51 from the Lake County Auditor’s Office as the City’s share of Coronavirus Relief Fund/CARES Act grant funding; and

WHEREAS, because the terms of the Coronavirus Relief Grant restrict the use of the money provided, on July 23, 2020 City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2020-44 creating the Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund in the City’s chart of accounts to account for the receipt and expenditure of Coronavirus Relief Grant funding received; and

WHEREAS, the attached “**Schedule of 2020 Appropriations – Revision No. 01**” revises the 2020 appropriation of the Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund No. 204 by \$532,400 from \$0 to \$532,400 to provide for the expenditure of the CARES; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the requested appropriation change, the Finance Director is also requesting that the County Budget Commission increase the estimated resources of the newly established Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund No. 204 by \$532,400 from \$0 to \$532,400, the amount of the Coronavirus Relief Grant/CARES Act grant funding received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2020-15 is hereby further amended to provide funds for additional operating, capital and program expenses incurred by the City due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), by increasing the appropriation of the Coronavirus Relief Special Revenue Fund No. 234 by \$532,400, from \$0 to \$532,400 in accordance with the Interoffice Memo from Finance Director Brichacek dated July 17, 2020 consisting of two (2) pages, attached hereto as the “**Exhibit “B**” and as referenced herein.

SECTION 2. The abovementioned sum as reflected in the “**Schedule of 2020 Appropriations – Revision No. 01**”, prepared July 17, 2020 marked as the “**Exhibit A**”, attached hereto, consisting of five (5) pages and incorporated herein by reference, be and hereby is set aside and appropriated hereafter.

SECTION 3. All monies in the Trust & Agency Funds Accounts are hereby deemed appropriated for their intended purposes.

SECTION 4. All expenditures within the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020 shall be made in accordance with the code accounts hereinabove set forth and shall be made within the appropriations herein provided. "Appropriation" as used means the total amount appropriated for the individual fund. Notwithstanding the financial detail herein presented, the Mayor or the Finance Director is authorized to transfer budgeted amounts within each fund provided that the total amount appropriated for the fund is not exceeded.

SECTION 5. The City Finance Director be and is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrants against the appropriations set forth upon presentation of proper vouchers.

SECTION 6. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


