### AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SOS TRUCKING COMPANY INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIMESTONE FOR THE YEAR 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Council of The City of Willoughby Hills on January 12, 2017, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids to secure the City's requirement of limestone for the year 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the Mayor in his Memorandum, dated February 15, 2017 directed to the Members of Council and Council Clerk, attached hereto as the "**Exhibit A**", consisting of one (1) page and incorporated herein by reference, finding the following bid of: **\$16.10** per ton delivered for #304 Limestone; **\$16.60** per ton delivered for #411 Limestone; **\$19.85** per ton delivered for #57 Limestone; and **\$20.10** per ton delivered for #1 and #2 Limestone Blend as submitted by SOS Trucking Company Inc to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid as submitted by SOS Trucking Company Inc of 8399 Timber Trail, Brecksville, Ohio 44141, pursuant to the bid summary attached hereto as part of the "**Exhibit A**", consisting of one (1) page and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.


**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the City's Service Department, and further reason to allow the City to immediately accept the bid and enter into a contract with SOS Trucking Company Inc so that the City may begin road repair as soon as possible; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


