AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF THE **ENGINEERING FEES** ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2017 STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT SPECIFICALLY FOR ROCKEFELLER FROM CHARDON ROAD TO EDDY ROAD AND STARK DRIVE AND **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, 2017 Street Rehabilitation Project is to consist of resurfacing approximately 1,762 lineal feet of Rockefeller Road between Chardon Road and Eddy Road and approximately 1,996 lineal feet of Stark Drive; and

WHEREAS, the resurfacing is anticipated to include recycling of the existing asphalt pavement for use as the base for a new asphalt overlay; and

WHEREAS, the engineering scope of services for the abovementioned project are as follows: (1) Serve as the authorized representative of the City and supervise the execution of the project work, including resident coordination and meetings as needed; (2) **Design and Document Preparation**: plans, specifications, cost estimate, and bid documents as needed; (3) Bidding Assistance: respond to bidder questions, tabulate and evaluate bids, assess contractor's ability, and make recommendation for award; (4) Construction Administration: respond to contractor questions, review contractor submittals, perform site visits, review change orders, review contractor payments, perform punch list and project close-out; and

WHEREAS, based on Section 2.2 and 2.3 of the "Agreement between City of Willoughby Hills, Ohio & Richard L. Bowen + Associates, Inc. for City Engineering Services", the Base Professional Services fee is estimated to be:
