ORDINANCE 2017-34

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2017 GMC 3500 PICKUP TRUCK AS PROVIDED THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Mayor's Interoffice Memo to Council President, Council Clerk and Council Members, dated May 26, 2017, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of four (4) pages, and incorporated herein by reference, a request was made by the Mayor to prepare an ordinance for the acquisition of a 2017 GMC 3500 Pickup Truck provided through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 Operating Budget provides funding for the abovementioned vehicle as follows: fifty percent (\$20,000) of the cost to be funded through the Sewer Enterprise Fund #610.680.56300-Capital Improvements/Equipment and fifty percent (\$20,000) of the cost to be funded through the Street Maintenance Fund #250.350.56300-Capital Improvements/New Vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Contract(s) for the purchase of a 2017 GMC 3500 pickup truck (State of Ohio Contract #RS901017, Index #GDC093, Item 27AT 3500 Pickup 12,800 4WD Reg CAB Long Bed Flex Fuel) with said vehicle being provided by vendor Bob Ross Auto Group, Government Sales Department, 85 Loop Road, Centerville, Ohio 45459 at a cost of \$36,329.50.

SECTION 2. Cost of said vehicle is not to exceed \$36,329.50 with fifty percent (50%) of the cost to be funded through the Sewer Enterprise Fund #610.680.56300-Capital Improvements/Equipment and the remaining fifty percent (50%) of the cost to be funded through the Street Maintenance Fund #250.350.56300-Capital Improvements/New Vehicles.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, and further provides for the usual daily operation of the Service Department, and further reason being to immediately secure a 2017 GMC 3500 pickup truck through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
