ORDINANCE 2017-35

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2016 GAPVAX COMBINATION JET/VACUUM AS PROVIDED THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Mayor's Interoffice Memo to Council President, Council Clerk and Council Members, dated May 26, 2017, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of three (3) pages, and incorporated herein by reference, a request was made by the Mayor to prepare an ordinance for the acquisition of a 2016 demo GapVax Combination Jet/Vacuum provided through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 Operating Budget allocated four-hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the acquisition of a sewer truck with one hundred percent of the cost to be funded through the Sewer Enterprise Fund #610.680.56300-Capital Improvements/Equipment.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Contract(s) for the purchase of a 2016 demo GapVax Combination Jet/Vacuum (State of Ohio Contract STS670, #800337) with said vehicle being provided by vendor MTech Company, 7401 First Place, Cleveland, Ohio 44146 at a cost of \$331,963.


SECTION 2. Cost of said vehicle is not to exceed \$331,963 and shall be one hundred percent (100%) funded through the Sewer Enterprise Fund #610.680.56300-Capital Improvements/Equipment.


SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, and further provides for the usual daily operation of the Service Department, and further reason being to immediately secure a 2016 demo GapVax Combination Jet/Vacuum through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
