ORDINANCE NO. 2017-42

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF THE ENGINEERING FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE MEADOWBROOK PUMP STATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the project consists of replacing the existing Meadowbrook Pump Station with a new premanufactured package pump station within the same existing easement area (see attached Sketch SK1.1); and

WHEREAS, the existing pump station building, tanks, and piping will be demolished and removed from off-site; and

WHEREAS, the existing 2.5-inch discharge force main will remain and be re-used; and

WHEREAS, the new package pump station will be supplied with a wet well, two (2) pumps, piping, controls, and an above ground enclosure as manufacture by Flygt or equal; and

WHEREAS, the facility will include an emergency generator powered by natural gas, and enclosed with a security fence; and

WHEREAS, a topographic survey, soil boring(s), and asbestos survey and plan will be contracted directly by the City; and

WHEREAS, the opinion of probable construction cost is approximately \$272,550.00 (see attached estimate); and

WHEREAS, the resurfacing is anticipated to include recycling of the existing asphalt pavement for use as the base for a new asphalt overlay; and

WHEREAS, the engineering scope of services for the abovementioned project are as follows: (1) Serve as the authorized representative of the City and supervise the execution of the project work, including resident coordination and meetings as needed; (2) Design and Document Preparation: plans, specifications, cost estimate, and bid documents as needed; (3) Bidding Assistance: respond to bidder questions, tabulate and evaluate bids, assess contractor's ability, and make recommendation for award; (4) Construction Administration: respond to contractor questions, review contractor submittals, perform site visits, review change orders, review contractor payments, perform punch list and project close-out; and

WHEREAS, based on Section 2.2 and 2.3 of the "Agreement between City of Willoughby Hills, Ohio & Richard L. Bowen + Associates, Inc. for City Engineering Services", the Base Professional Services fee is estimated to be:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the proposal, dated June 15, 2017, as submitted by Richard L. Bowen + Associates, Inc., consisting of four (4) pages, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", providing design services for the Meadowbrook Pump Station Project at a projected cost of \$31,898.13.

SECTION 2. Cost for said project is to be funded by and through the Sewer Enterprise Fund #610.

SECTION 3. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to provide a City-issued purchase order for said authorized expenditure.

SECTION 4. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the municipality and further reason being that the City requires the immediate professional services enumerated within this ordinance to seek bids required for the Meadowbrook Pump Station Project; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
