## ORDINANCE NO. 2017-51

### **AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF FIRE CHIEF AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT A OF ORDINANCE NO. 2014-74; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.32 of the Charter of the City of Willoughby Hills requires that the Council fix by Ordinance the compensation of every officer and employee of the Municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2014-74 adopted by Council on December 11, 2014 established the compensation for every officer and employee of the Municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the position of Fire Chief has been vacant since September 16, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the compensation range as set forth by Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 2014-74 for the position of Fire Chief is no longer pertinent.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The salary range of \$65,728 - \$96,115 as set for in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 2014-74 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** All the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Fire Department, and further allows the compensation for the position of Fire Chief to be properly set by Council upon confirmation of the appointment of a Fire Chief; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
