ORDINANCE NO. 2017-83

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE FIREARMS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VI – LEGISLATION, SECTION 6.01 – GENERAL ORDINANCES, SUBSECTION (e) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Police Chief Collins requested that various firearms, as identified in his memorandum to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, dated November 27, 2017, be declared as surplus and disposed of for the benefit of the City of Willoughby Hills; and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2017, Police Chief Collins revised the abovementioned memorandum by requesting that four additional firearms with a total estimated value of \$3,500 be declared as surplus; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 6.01(e), Council shall make provision by ordinance for the sale or disposal of Municipal property; and

WHEREAS, this Council determines that the surplus firearms should be released to Atwell's Police & Fire Equipment Company in Painesville for a credit, in the amounts described below, that will be applied to the purchase price of the City's weapons and range program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. Based upon the recommendation of the Police Chief, this Council finds that the firearms set forth within this section are no longer needed for use by the Police Department, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and thus are surplus property.

SECTION 2. The surplus firearms are to be released to Atwell's Police & Fire Equipment Company in Painesville for credit towards the City's weapons and range program.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were held in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, and for the further purpose of ensuring that the City can expeditiously dispose of firearms which are obsolete and unfit for use by the Police Department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force effective immediately, after its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor, or as otherwise provided by the Charter of the City of Willoughby Hills.
