## ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1

---

### **AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SECURE THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW POLICE VEHICLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

---

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Police Department Memorandum from Chief Christopher J. Collins to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, dated January 1, 2019, Police Chief Collins respectfully requested approval to purchase two new police vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, Classic Auto Group, Mentor, Ohio 44060 would provide two 2019 Police Package Dodge Chargers with options, as Classic was able to beat the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. RS900718, effective 10/26/2018 to 9/30/2019, by one hundred and seventy-four dollars (\$174.00); and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the Mayor's approval of Chief Christopher Collins' request for <sup>the</sup> purchase of two (2) 2019 Police Package Dodge Chargers, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills is in agreement with the immediate purchase of said vehicles by utilizing funds from **Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund/Capital New Vehicles #234.230.56600**.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all necessary documents to secure the purchase of: two (2) 2019 Police Package Dodge Chargers from Classic Auto Group, Mentor, Ohio 44060.

**SECTION 2.** The above mentioned two new police vehicles are being purchased by utilizing funds from the Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund/Capital New Vehicles #234.230.56600 at an estimated cost of seventy-seven thousand, three hundred and four dollars (**\$77,304.00**).

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Police Department, and further reason being that this will allow the City to immediately order two police vehicles to ensure that the vehicles would be in service by mid-year; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


