ORDINANCE NO. 2019-15

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in his Police Department Memorandum to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, dated February 15, 2019, Police Chief Collins requested an ordinance to dispose of surplus firearms; and

WHEREAS, in his Interoffice Memo to Council President, Council Members and Council Clerk, the Mayor serving as the Safety Director requested legislation to dispose of the various firearms identified by Police Chief Collins; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Section 721.15(A), personal property not needed for municipal purposes, the estimated value of which is less than one thousand dollars, may be sold by the board or officer having supervision or management of that property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The various firearms and simunition kits set forth within this section are no longer needed for use by the Police Department, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were held in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, and for the further purpose of ensuring that the City can expeditiously dispose of firearms which are obsolete and unfit for use by the Police Department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force effective immediately, after its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor, or as otherwise provided by the Charter of the City of Willoughby Hills.
