ORDINANCE NO. 2019-17

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GRAND RIVER ASPHALT CO. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT FOR THE YEAR 2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of Willoughby Hills on January 24, 2019, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids to secure the City's requirement of asphalt for the year 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the Mayor in his memorandum, dated February 20, 2019 directed to the Members of Council and Council Clerk, finding the following bid of: **\$65.00** per ton/picked up for ODOT 448 - Type 1 Asphalt Concrete (Surface Course); **\$55.00** per ton/picked up for ODOT 448 - Type 2 Asphalt Concrete (Intermediate Course); **\$54.00** per ton/picked up for ODOT - #301 Asphalt Concrete Base as submitted by Grand River Asphalt Co. to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid as submitted by Grand River Asphalt Co. of 6 US Coast Guard Road, Painesville, Ohio 44077, attached hereto the "Exhibit A", consisting of one page and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the City's Service Department, and further reason to allow the City to immediately accept the bid and enter into a contract with Grand River Asphalt Co. so that the City may begin road repair as soon as possible; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
