ORDINANCE NO. 2019-63 – As Amended

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE CITY VEHICLE(S) AND/OR EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND GRANTING AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SAID SURPLUS VEHICLE(S) AND EQUIPMENT ON THE OPEN MARKET UPON SUCH TERMS AND AT SUCH PRICES AS ARE DEEMED MOST ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for methods to dispose of surplus personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills wishes to dispose of certain items deemed no longer needed for municipal purposes in a manner consistent with the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The following vehicle(s) with an estimated value of \$1,000 or more be and are hereby declared to be surplus property of the City and are available for disposition through sale and/or internet auction:

2014 Dodge Charger	VIN: 2C3CDXAT7EH366645
Mileage: 94,346	Estimated Value: \$5,500
2010 Chevrolet Police Impala	VIN: 2G1WD5EM9A1259432
Mileage: 90,093	Estimated Value: \$4,900

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with any internet auction house or company deemed most advantageous for the City to participate in its internet-based auction system to sell the above-referenced vehicles.

SECTION 3. The internet-based auction will be conducted in accordance with the standard procedures of such internet auction house or company and the number of days for bidding on the above-referenced items shall be a minimum of ten (10) days.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance; specifically, Ordinance No. 2019-62

SECTION 5. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual operation of a municipal department; to wit: to immediately expedite the sale of vehicles and or equipment declared as surplus property by City Ordinance; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
