ORDINANCE NO. 2015-28

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART ONE – ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE FIVE – ADMINISTRATIVE, CHAPTER 157 – GENERAL EMPLOYMENT PROVISIONS, SECTION 157.18 – UNIFORM ALLOWANCE FOR SAFETY FORCES, SUB-SECTION (a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS AND REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Interoffice Memo to Council President, Council Clerk and the Members of Council, dated June 17, 2015, consisting of two (2) pages and attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", the Mayor stated that he was in receipt of a memo dated June 16, 2015 from Police Chief Collins recommending that **Charter 157 – General Employment Provisions, Section 157.18 – Uniform Allowance for Safety Forces** be amended as a result of the recent appointment of Officer Jim Ours to the position of Community Safety Officer; and

WHEREAS, as further stated in said Memo, the Mayor approved the recommendation brought forth by the Police Chief and respectfully requested that Council prepare the required legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. Sub-Section (a) of Section 157.18 - Uniform Allowance for Safety Forces of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills be, and it hereby is amended to read and provide in its entirety as follows:

"157.18 UNIFORM ALLOWANCE FOR SAFETY FORCES.


(a) The Chief of Police and Community Service Officer shall receive a uniform allowance in the same amount as provided to the Patrol Officers and Sergeants as contained in their union agreement."

SECTION 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and they are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
