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ORDINANCE NO. 2015-31 AS AMENDED

Amended during the Regular Council Meeting of July 9, 2015 and reflected in the Minutes thereof.

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SECURE THE PURCHASE OF TWO POWER LIFT COTS AND ONE POWER LOAD SYSTEM FOR BUDGET YEAR 2015 THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT CONTRACT WITH SAID PURCHASE BEING EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department submitted an application for a "Safety Grant" in the amount of \$40,000 from The Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Safety Grant is to equip the City's ambulances with two Power Lift cots and to provide one ambulance with a Power Load System for the cot; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of power cots with accessories will potentially reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles; this intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting; and

WHEREAS, funding for the acquisition will be provided by the award of a Safety Grant in the amount of \$40,000 and by utilizing funds from #234 – Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. Upon receipt of the Safety Grant in the amount of \$40,000 from The Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation the Mayor shall execute the terms of the Safety Grant Agreement by lending his signature to any and all documents necessary to secure the purchase of: two Stryker Model 6506 Power Cots and Accessories (\$38,299.36); one Stryker Model 6309 Power Load and Accessories (23,853.88) and Installation of Model 6309 Power Load (\$1,613.50) for a total budgeted cost of \$63,766.74.

SECTION 2. The above mentioned equipment is being purchased through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Schedule No. 800288, Index No. STS233, Effective 03/07/2013 to 02/28/2018: Listed Vendor American Emergency Vehicles and Dealer Rolland Specialty Vehicles & Products, Inc.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Fire Department, and further reason to wit: to allow the City to fully comply with the program requirements as outlined in the *Application and Instructions and QAC 4123-17-56*, all of which are fully incorporated in the *Agreement between Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation and the City of Willoughby Hills*, consisting of two (2) pages attached

hereto as the "Exhibit A"; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
