ORDINANCE NO. 2015-41

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS AND THE CITY OF KIRTLAND TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE WORRELL ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills in conjunction with the City of Kirtland is planning to make Capital Improvements to Worrell Road from the Geauga County Line north to Euclid-Chardon Road; and

WHEREAS, said infrastructure improvement project is considered to be a priority need for both communities and is a qualified project under the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Programs; and

WHEREAS, in his letter dated May 29, 2015 to the City of Willoughby Hills Mayor Mark A. Tyler of the City of Kirtland stated that the City of Kirtland supports Willoughby Hills' proposed OPWC Round 30 application for the reconstruction of Worrell Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills and the City of Kirtland wish to enter into a Cooperation Agreement to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Worrell Road Resurfacing Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor shall be, and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Cooperative Agreement between the City of Willoughby Hills and the City of Kirtland to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Worrell Road Resurfacing Project pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in said Agreement attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of two (2) pages, incorporated herein by reference

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills and of the City of Kirtland, to wit: to insure the timely filing of an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission for funding necessary for the Worrell Road Resurfacing Project; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


