ORDINANCE NO. 2015-42

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LAKE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY AND THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS FOR THE S.R. 91 RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the terms of NOACA'S Provisional Transportation Asset Management policy, SR91 in the cities of Willoughby and Willoughby Hills are eligible in FY2016 (Resolution 2015-031) for roadway improvements; and

WHEREAS, NOACA has notified the cities that the proposed improvement is from the Cuyahoga County line to SR20 in Willoughby; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has approved the proposed improvement and has designated the project as PID#100245; and

WHEREAS, Willoughby and Willoughby Hills has asked the Lake County Engineer's Office to manage the project; and

WHEREAS, Willoughby and Willoughby Hills have agreed to cooperate to complete the resurfacing project under the conditions contained in the *Agreement between The Lake County Commissioners, The City of Willoughby Hills and The City of Willoughby Hills* attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", containing four (4) pages and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor shall be, and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a *Agreement between The Lake County Commissioners, The City of Willoughby Hills and The City of Willoughby Hills* for the S.R.91 Resurfacing Project (PID#100245) pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in said Agreement attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of four (4) pages, incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills and of the City of Willoughby, to wit: to expedite in a timely manner the required Agreement necessary for the resurfacing of S.R. 91 as this is considered to be a fast track project; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
