ORDINANCE NO. 2017-30

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PAT FLOWERS, INC. OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO FOR THE 2017 CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS PAVEMENT MARKINGS PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on March 23, 2017 by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for the 2017 Pavement Markings Program; and

WHEREAS, the project was advertised in the News Herald on April 18, 2017 as well as on the City's website; and

WHEREAS, invitations to bid were distributed to five pavement marking contractors and bid documents were distributed to The Builder's Exchange and iSqft planrooms; and

WHEREAS, three contractors purchased bid documents and all three contractors submitted bids by the May 9, 2017 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the bids ranged from a low bid of \$48,606.75 to a high bid of \$62,281.46 as compared to the Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost of \$56,631.00; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the City Engineer Pietro DiFranco and the Assistant City Engineer Kevin Trepal, P.E. in their Memorandum of May 11, 2017, attached hereto as the "**Exhibit A**", consisting of three (3) pages and incorporated herein by reference, finding the bid of \$48,606.75 as submitted by Pat Flowers, Inc. to be the lowest bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of and thereby enter into a contract with Pat Flowers, Inc. of 6044 Whiteford Drive, Highland Heights, Ohio 44143, for the 2017 City of Willoughby Hills Pavement Markings Program at a total cost not to exceed \$48,606.75.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return the bid bonds to all unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the municipality and further reason to allow the City to accept the bid of Pat Flowers, Inc. thereby allowing for the immediate execution of the contract in order to proceed with the 2017 City of Willoughby Hills Pavement Markings Program; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor
