## ORDINANCE NO. 2013-17

*As Amended during the Regular Council Meeting of April 25, 2013 and reflected in the Minutes thereof.*

### **AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF LAKE ERIE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY OF NORWALK, OHIO FOR THE 2013 GUARD RAIL PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on February 28, 2013 by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for the 2013 Guard Rail Project; and

WHEREAS, the Bids received ranged from a low bid of \$34,335.00 to a high bid of \$56,117.85; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the Mayor, in his Memorandum of April 12, 2013, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", consisting of four (4) pages and incorporated herein by reference, finding the bid of \$34,335.00 submitted by Lake Erie Construction Company of 23 South Norwalk Road, Norwalk, Ohio, 44857 to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

***NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:***

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of and thereby enter into a contract with Lake Erie Construction Company of 23 South Norwalk Road, Norwalk, Ohio, 44857, for the 2013 City of Willoughby Hills Guard Rail Project at a total cost not to exceed \$34,335.00.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return the bid bonds to all unsuccessful bidders.

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


**SECTION 4.** *This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department; to wit: due to the time sensitivity of the project which requires the City to immediately proceed with the 2013 Guard Rail Project; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.*


