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ORDINANCE NO. 2012-50

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH CHAGRIN RIVER WATERSHED PARTNERS, INC. TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE STORMWATER DESIGN AT THE CITY'S COMMUNITY CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills directed CT Consultants, Inc. to prepare a grant application to the Chagrin River Watershed Partners, Inc. (CRWP) to fund the engineering design tasks associated with best stormwater management practices at the City's Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City was successful and received a grant from CRWP for the design of said improvements at the Community Center to demonstrate the effectiveness of certain stormwater management practices as a demonstration project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the funding assistance and formalize the relationship with CRWP pursuant to the terms and conditions of a Contract Agreement considered to be a part of this Ordinance and attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City has elected to proceed with the Community Center stormwater improvements at this time to maintain the schedule and the commitment made in a second funding application to the Ohio EPA to secure the construction funds for these improvements and wishes to now authorize that professional engineering services be provided for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract agreement with the Chagrin River Watershed Partners, Inc. to provide funding assistance and other professional services for the design of best stormwater management practices at the City's Community Center; substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the Contract Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and consisting of four (4) pages and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department and further reason being to maintain the schedule and the commitment made in a second funding application to the Ohio EPA to secure the construction funds for these improvements and wishes to now authorize that professional engineering services be provided for the project; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
