## ORDINANCE NO. 2013 – 6

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**AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SECURE THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES FOR BUDGET YEAR 2013 THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT CONTRACT WITH SAID PURCHASE BEING EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.04 (C) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Police Department Memorandum from Chief Christopher J. Collins to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, dated December 18, 2012, Police Chief Collins has respectfully requested approval for the purchase of: two (2) 2012 Dodge Charger Police Models from Greve Chrysler, Dodge & Jeep, 756 West Ervin Road, Van Wert, Ohio, 45891 and one (1) Chevrolet Tahoe 4x2 Police Model from Byers, 555 Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with State Contract Law Enforcement Vehicle Specifications and pricing with available options, the two 2012 Dodge Charger Police Models are at a cost of \$23,659.00 each for a total cost not to exceed **\$47,318.00** and the Chevrolet Tahoe 4x2 Police Model is at a total cost not to exceed **\$26,612.00**; and

**WHEREAS**, with said purchase costs not to include equipment changeover, the installation and decaling which is estimated to be an additional **\$30,000.00**; and

**WHEREAS**, the total estimated cost to purchase and outfit the cars would be **\$103,930.00**; and

**WHEREAS**, to continue the City's vital Police Car Rotation Program, started in 2003, the new police vehicles will be rotated into the police fleet and the older vehicles will be rotated out for disposal as surplus; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the Mayor's approval of Chief Christopher Collins' request for purchase of two (2) 2012 Dodge Chargers Police Models and one (1) Chevrolet Tahoe 4x2 Police Model, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills is in agreement with the immediate purchase of said vehicles by utilizing funds from **#234 – Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund**.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all necessary documents to secure the purchase of: two (2) Dodge Chargers from Greve Chrysler, Dodge & Jeep located at 756 West Erving Road, Van Wert, Ohio, 45891 for a total purchase price of **\$47,318.00** and one (1) Chevrolet Tahoe 4x2 Police Model from from Byers, 555 Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215 for a total purchase price of **\$26,612.00** Said purchase costs not to include equipment changeover, installation and decaling.

**SECTION 2.** The above mentioned three new police vehicles for the Budget Year 2013 are being purchased through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. RS901213, effective 11/26/2012 to 10/31/2013.

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Police Department, and further reason being that this will allow the City to utilize the price quotes as received from Greve Chrysler, Dodge and Byers provided through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract without jeopardizing the availability of the vehicles; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


