ORDINANCE NO. 2013-30

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF LCI CONSTRUCTION, INC. OF KIRTLAND, OHIO FOR THE STORMWATER RETROFIT – PERVIOUS PAVERS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2013 the City received one bid in the amount of \$63,475.00 from LCI Construction, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the *Opinion of Probable Construction Cost* was \$65,000.00; and

WHEREAS, after review and verification of the submitted bid, it is the professional opinion of CT Consultant, Inc. that LCI Construction, Inc. of Kirtland, Ohio is experienced and qualified to perform the work within the scope of the contract; and


WHEREAS, based upon the Letter of the Project Manager dated June 5, 2013 regarding the Stormwater Retrofit – Pervious Pavers – Bid Results along with the Bid Tabulation for said Project, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", consisting of two (2) pages and incorporated herein by reference, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills accepts the lowest and best bid of \$63,475.00 as submitted by LCI Construction, Inc.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of and thereby enter into a contract with LCI Construction, Inc. of 8297 Chardon Road, Kirtland, Ohio for the Stormwater Retrofit – Pervious Pavers Project for a total cost not to exceed \$63,475.00.

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department; to wit: due to the time sensitivity of the project which requires the City to immediately proceed with the Stormwater Retrofit – Pervious Pavers Project; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.




