ORDINANCE NO. 2014-8

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (DISPATCHERS) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2013, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills adopted Ordinance No. 2013-52 providing authorization and directing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified and outlined in the *"Agreement between the City of Willoughby Hills and Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Dispatchers), effective January 1, 2014, expiring on December 31, 2016"*; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Finance Director's Memo to the Mayor's Assistant, pertaining to the subject matter of "Dispatchers Contract, possible error" stated that while processing the payroll, it was noted that Article XXV – Salary Schedule was incorrect; for it did not reflect the established rate of 1% in 2014, 1% in 2015 and 2% in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the legal representative for the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Dispatchers) was contacted with regard to said error and had requested that legislation be prepared to correct the error, and stipulated that there would be no recoupment of monies paid to date in error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Salary Schedule of the collective bargaining *"Agreement between the City of Willoughby Hills and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Dispatchers), effective January 1, 2014, expiring on December 31, 2016"* is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

SECTION 2. Said amendment *to the Agreement between The City of Willoughby Hills and The Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Dispatchers)*, effective January 1, 2014, expiring on December 31, 2016, shall be considered part thereof the original Agreement, any inconsistencies herewith shall be resolved in favor of the amendment.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department and further reason being that it will immediately provide for the effective date of change to be February 2, 2014 in order to make the correction for the entirety of the pay period beginning February 2, 2014 through February 15, 2014; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.


