ORDINANCE NO. 2014-32

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2014 FORD F350 SEWER VEHICLE FOR USE BY THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage said opportunity by acquiring a 2014 Ford F350 Sewer Vehicle (State of Ohio Contract #GDC093/ITEM #35BT), including additional Off-Contract Options as provided by vendor Walt Sweeney, Government Sales Department of 5400 Glenway Avenue, Cincinnati, Ohio 45238.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor accordingly be and is hereby authorized and directed to request authority in the name of the City of Willoughby Hills to participate in Ohio Department of Administrative Services Contract(s) for the purchase of a 2014 Ford F350 Sewer Vehicle (State of Ohio Contract #GDC093/ITEM #35BT), including additional Off-Contract Options with said vehicle being provided by vendor Walt Sweeney, Government Sales Department at a cost not to exceed \$48,750.00.

SECTION 3. The City of Willoughby Hills hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of Administrative Services for the abovementioned purchase(s) and/or service(s), and to directly pay the vendor, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services in which the City participates for items and/or services it receives pursuant to the contract.

SECTION 4. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into and execute such Agreements and Documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.


SECTION 5. Pursuant to Finance Director Brichacek's Interoffice Memo to Councilman Frank Germano, Utilities Committee Chairman, dated March 13, 2014, the 2014 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget included \$101,000 for the acquisition of new sewer maintenance equipment. To date, none of the 2014 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget has been obligated; therefore, said Fund should be more than sufficient to finance the estimated cost \$49,000 for the sewer vehicle.

SECTION 6. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


