## ORDINANCE NO. 2015-12

### **AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF LONGO SEWER CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. OF SOUTH EUCLID, OHIO FOR THE LAMPLIGHT LANE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on January 28, 2015 by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for the Lamplight Lane Culvert Replacement Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bids received ranged from a low bid of \$253,242 to a high bid of \$363,651 as compared to the Opinion of Probable Cost (Budget) of \$273,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the City Engineer Pietro DiFranco, in his Memorandum of March 6, 2015, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of four (4) pages and incorporated herein by reference, finding the bid of \$265,892.00 as submitted by Longo Sewer Construction Co., Inc. of 4197 Greenvale Drive, South Euclid, Ohio 44121 to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of and thereby enter into a contract with Longo Sewer Construction Co., Inc. of 4197 Greenvale Drive, South Euclid, Ohio 44121, for the Lamplight Lane Culvert Replacement Project at a total cost not to exceed \$265,892.00.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return the bid bonds to all unsuccessful bidders.

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Municipality and further reason to allow the City to accept the bid of Longo Sewer Construction Co., Inc. thereby allowing for the immediate execution of the contract to provide valuable lead time of 3-5 weeks for procurement and delivery of required materials before said project can begin.


