ORDINANCE NO. 2015-13

EXCAVATING, THE BID OF WOODFORD ORDINANCE ACCEPTING LLC AN LEAVITTSBURG, OHIO FOR THE KNECHT-O'BRIEN CHANNEL RESTORATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on January 28, 2015 by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for the Knecht-O'Brien Culvert Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Bids received ranged from a low bid of \$168,462.02 to a high bid of \$292,181.50 as compared to the Opinion of Probable Cost (Budget) of \$197,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the City Engineer Pietro DiFranco, in his Memorandum of March 6, 2015, attached hereto as the "Exhibit A", consisting of three (3) pages and incorporated herein by reference, finding the bid of \$168,462.02 as submitted by Woodford Excavating LLC of 701 Diehe South Road, Leavittsburg, Ohio 44430 to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

NOW. THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of and thereby enter into a contract with Woodford Excavating, LLC of 701 Diehe South Road, Leavittsburg, Ohio 44430, for the Knecht-O'Brien Channel Restoration Project at a total cost not to exceed \$168,462.02.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return the bid bonds to all unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Municipality and further reason to allow the City to accept the bid of Woodford Excavating, LLC thereby allowing for the immediate execution of the contract to provide valuable lead time of 3-5 weeks for procurement and delivery of required materials before said project can begin.
