ORDINANCE NO. 2014-31

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT(S) FOR THE REMOUNTING AND REFURBISHING OF ONE 2003 LIFELINE SUPERLINER AMBULANCE FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH THE TRADE-IN AND CREDIT OF THE EXISTING CHASSIS.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage of that opportunity for the remounting and refurbishing of one (1) 2003 Lifeline Superliner Ambulance (Schedule/Contract No. 800217, Index No. STS233) for use by the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, this Council is desirous of having the Mayor serving as the Safety Director, sell and/or trade-in the existing chassis as it will no longer be required for municipal use, and have the selling price and or trade-in value credited against the cost of remounting and refurbishing the 2003 Lifeline Superliner Ambulance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council finds that the Fire Department of the City of Willoughby Hills has an existing 2003 Ford Chassis, VIN#1FDXE45F73HB22313, which will no longer be required for municipal use and therefore finds that it would be in the best interests of the City to sell and/or trade-in such equipment simultaneously through State Contract, and have the selling and/or trade-in value be applied as a credit against the costs of remounting and refurbishing the 2003 Lifeline Superliner Ambulance.

SECTION 2. The Mayor accordingly be and is hereby authorized and directed to request authority in the name of the City of Willoughby Hills to participate in Ohio Department of Administrative Services contracts with Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc. and Life Line Emergency Vehicles, Inc. for the remount/refurbishment of (1) 2003 Life Line Superliner Ambulance, body number 162103, VIN#1FDXE45F73HB22313 on to a 2014 Ford E-450 Gas Engine Chassis per State Term Pricing Schedule with said remount procedure to be performed at the Life Line factory in Sumner, IA and providing for the sale and/or trade-in of the existing chassis with an estimated value of \$5,691.00 to be credited towards the Remount/Refurbishment of said Ambulance for a total amount not to exceed \$107,543.00.

SECTION 3. The City of Willoughby Hills hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of Administrative Services for such purchases and/or services, and to directly pay the vendor(s), under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services in which the City participates for items and/or services it receives pursuant to the contract.


SECTION 4. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into and execute such Agreements and Documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 5. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2014-5, this Council accepted the recommendation of the Finance Director to finance the appropriation revisions by decreasing the estimated resources of the Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund No. 234 by \$100,000 to provide for the decision not to issue a bond anticipation note at this time to finance the ambulance acquisition. The current plan is to initially finance the ambulance refurbishment contract, estimated to be \$110,000 from the Capital Fund No. 420's unobligated carryover fund balance of \$355,051 as of January 1, 2014.

SECTION 6. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.




