AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE FIREARMS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.27 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, Police Chief Collins requested that various items, as identified in his Memorandum to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, dated February 27, 2008, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", consisting of (1) page and incorporated herein by reference, be declared surplus; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 721.15 (A) – Disposition of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property states: "Personal property not needed for municipal purposes, the estimated value of which is less than one thousand dollars, may be sold by the board or officer having supervision or management of that property. If the estimated value of that property is one thousand dollars or more, it shall be sold only when authorized by an ordinance of the legislative authority of the municipal corporation and approved by the board, officer, or director having supervision or management of that property. When so authorized, the board, officer, or director shall make a written contract with the highest and best bidder after advertisement for not less than two or more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation, or with a board of county commissioners upon such lawful terms as are agreed upon, as provided by Division (B) (1) of Section 721.27 of the Ohio Revised Code".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The following weapons released to the Willoughby Hills Police Department by Court Order; said weapons were seized during criminal cases are not being used by the Willoughby Hills Police Department and are hereby declared to be surplus property of the City:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The declared surplus weapons are to be turned in to Ralph Spidalari, a federally licensed gun dealer who is able to accept these weapons in accordance with Federal and State Law and owner of Great Lakes Outdoor Supply, Middlefield, Ohio.

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SECTION 3. Said declared surplus weapons are to be traded for credit for firearms range time. The City of Willoughby Hills leases the outdoor firearms range at Great Lakes Outdoor Supply, Middlefield, Ohio to conduct all of the State mandated firearms qualifications and training.

SECTION 4. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
