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ORDINANCE NO. 2008 – 11

(Amended during the Regular Council Meeting of March 13, 2008 and is reflected in the Minutes thereof)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS TO ENTER INTO A LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A 2008 CHEVROLET TAHOE FROM TAYLOR CHEVROLET AT OHIO STATE CONTRACTOR PRICING PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE OHIO HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING **AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, in his Memorandum dated February 8, 2008 to Mayor/Safety Director Robert M. Weger, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", consisting of five (5) pages, Police Chief Collins requested approval to enter into a Lease/Purchase Agreement to obtain a 2008 Chevrolet Tahoe at Ohio State Contractor Pricing; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the base vehicle is \$26,354.00; the following options have been added: four (4) wheel drive at a cost of \$2,995.00, side-impact airbags at a cost of \$349.00 along with a \$100 deduct for removing the spot light for a total cost of \$29,598.00; and

WHEREAS, the Ford Motor Credit A.P.R. for the lease/purchase option is 5.95% with three (3) annual payments of \$10,441.40 for a total cost of \$31,324.20; and

WHEREAS, this purchase will be funded by the WHPD Law Enforcement Trust Fund with the State/Federal reimbursement checks from the Task Force to be deposited back into the Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle will be assigned to the City's Officer on the Ohio High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Northern Ohio Law Enforcement Task Force and partially funded (\$18,000.00 or 55%) by the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills will pay the annual payment in full each of the three (3) years, file the paperwork with the Task Force Financial Officer and receive a reimbursement for the State/Federal cost share per the terms of the Ohio HIDTA Memorandum of Understanding, attached hereto as "Exhibit B", consisting of two (2) pages and referenced herein; and

WHEREAS, at the end of the three (3) year lease the City shall then purchase the vehicle for \$1.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Lease/Purchase Agreement for the procurement of a 2008 Chevrolet Tahoe from Taylor Chevrolet, located at 2510 N. Memorial Drive, P. O. Box 10, Lancaster, Ohio 43130 at Ohio State, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the Ford Municipal Finance Program Quotation for Willoughby Hills, Ohio, Bid #55053, lease/purchase option of 5.95% with three (3) annual payments of \$10,441.40 for a total cost not to exceed \$31,324.20.

SECTION 2. Said vehicle shall be purchased in accordance with and pursuant to the terms set forth by the Ohio High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Memorandum of Understanding attached hereto as "Exhibit B", consisting of two (2) pages and referenced herein.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual operation of the Police Department and it is of the utmost urgency to proceed with said lease/purchase agreement through the Ford Municipal Finance Program whereby the quotation for Willoughby Hills, Ohio – Bid #55053 is good until 04/30/2008; vehicle delivery must take place and all required documentation and payments must be received by Ford Credit by the good thru date. After 04/30/2008, rates and payments are subject to change; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.


