ORDINANCE NO. 2008-46

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A STRATEGIC NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES AND MAINTENANCE PROPOSAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, OHIO AND NET IT SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Proposal Agreement is by and between the City of Willoughby Hills, Ohio and NetIT Solutions, LLC of 197 Great Oaks Trail, #133, Wadsworth, Ohio 44281; and

WHEREAS, the City has existing infrastructure that needs to be supported and maintained to allow for faster service level agreements; and

WHEREAS, to meet the City's technology challenges, it is imperative that the services of highly qualified and professional engineers are secured to provide technology services, as well as remote and project support for the City's existing infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the said technology services to be provided by NetIT Solutions, LLC are exempt from the Ohio's Design Professional Selection Law as defined in Section 153.65-71 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a *Strategic Network Infrastructure Services and Maintenance Proposal* Agreement (dated May 15, 2008) with NetIT Solutions, LLC of 197 Great Oaks Ttrail, #133, Wadsworth, Ohio, 44281, pursuant to the terms and conditions identified and outlined in said Proposal Agreement, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", consisting of (8) pages and incorporated herein by reference, at a total price not to exceed Fifty-Three Thousand, Seven Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$53,760.00).

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The *Strategic Network Infrastructure Services and Maintenance Proposal* Agreement is a one (1) year support agreement and shall become effective immediately upon execution. Any pricing information that may be contained within the said Proposal Agreement is deemed accurate as of Thursday, May 15, 2008. The Customer (City) will provide NetIT Solutions with thirty (30) business days' notice prior to termination of the Scope of Work document.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual operation of a Municipal Department and for further reason being that this allows the City to immediately secure technology support services for the City's IT Infrastructure with said Proposal Agreement to become effective immediately upon execution; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
