ORDINANCE NO. 2008-62

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART ONE – ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE ONE – GENERAL PROVISIONS BY THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF CHAPTER 105 – DISTRICTS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 3501.18 (A) of the Ohio Revised Code states: "The board of elections may divide a political subdivision within its jurisdiction into precincts, establish, define, divide, rearrange, and combine the several election precincts within its jurisdiction, and change the location of the polling place for each precinct when it is necessary to maintain the requirements as to the number of voters in a precinct and to provide for the convenience of the voters and the proper conduct of elections. No change in the number of precincts or in precinct boundaries shall be made during the twenty-five days immediately receding a primary or general election or between the first day of January and the day on which the members of county central committees are elected in the years in which those committees are elected. Except as otherwise provided in division (C) of this section, each precinct shall contain a number of electors, not to exceed one thousand four hundred, that the board of elections determines to be a reasonable number after taking into consideration the type and amount of available equipment, prior voter turnout, the size and location of each selected polling place, available parking, availability of an adequate number of poll workers, and handicap accessibility and other accessibility to the polling place."; and

WHEREAS, the voting districts within the City of Willoughby Hills have been predicated upon the boundaries of its voting precincts defined by the Lake County Board of Elections through the number of electors within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Elections has advised and encouraged the City of Willoughby Hills to set forth by Ordinance, the boundaries of said voting districts.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Part One – Administrative Code, Title One – General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills be, and it hereby is amended by the creation and establishment of a new **Chapter 105 – Districts and Boundaries** which shall read and provide in its entirety as follows:

"Chapter 105 Districts and Boundaries

105.1 MAP INCORPORATED.

The Map of Willoughby Hills delineating the boundaries of the Districts as herein described, prepared by the City Engineer, shall be filed with the Clerk of Council and made a part of the permanent records of the City.

105.2 <u>DISTRICT 1</u>.

Beginning in the southerly corporation line of the City of Willoughby Hills, the same being the line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga, at its intersection with the centerline of Worrell Road, said centerline also being the line which separates said City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Kirtland;

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Thence westerly along said line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga to its intersection with the centerline of the Chagrin River Road (State Route No. 174);

Thence northerly along said centerline of the Chagrin River Road to its intersection with the centerline of Eddy Road;

Thence southwesterly along said centerline of Eddy Road to its intersection with the centerline of SOM Center Road (State Route No. 91);

Thence northerly along said centerline of SOM Center Road to its intersection with the northerly line of Interstate Route No. 90;

Thence northeasterly along said northerly line of Interstate Route No. 90 to its intersection with the line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Willoughby;

Thence northeasterly along said line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Willoughby to its intersection with the line which separates said City of Willoughby Hills from the Village of Waite Hill;

Thence southerly along said line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the Village of Waite Hill, the same being the center of the Chagrin River, to its intersection with the aforesaid line separating the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Kirtland;

Thence southerly along said line separating the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Kirtland to the point of beginning.

105.3 <u>DISTRICT 2</u>.

Beginning in the southerly corporation line of the City of Willoughby Hills, the same being the line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga, at its intersection with the centerline of Rockefeller Road;

Thence westerly along said line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga to a corner therein;

Thence northerly along said line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga to its intersection with the line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Wickliffe;

Thence easterly along said line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Wickliffe to its intersection with the centerline of Rockefeller Road;

Thence southeasterly along said centerline of Rockefeller Road to its intersection with the centerline of Eddy Road;

Thence easterly along said centerline of Eddy Road to its intersection with the centerline of Oak Street;

Thence southerly along said centerline of Oak Street to its intersection with the centerline of Chardon Road (U.S. Route No. 6);

Thence westerly along said centerline of Chardon Road to its intersection with the aforesaid centerline of Rockefeller Road;

Thence southerly along said centerline of Rockefeller Road to the point of beginning.

105.4 <u>DISTRICT 3</u>.

Beginning in the southerly corporation line of the City of Willoughby Hills, the same being the line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga, at its intersection with the centerline of the Chagrin River Road (State Route No. 174);

Thence northerly along said centerline of the Chagrin River Road to its intersection with the centerline of Eddy Road;

Thence southwesterly along said centerline of Eddy Road to its intersection with the centerline of SOM Center Road (State Route No. 91);

Thence northerly along said centerline of SOM Center Road to its intersection with the northerly line of Interstate Route No. 90;

Thence northeasterly along said northerly line of Interstate Route No. 90 to its intersection with the line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Willoughby;

Thence westerly along said line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Willoughby to its intersection with the line which separates said City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Wickliffe;

Thence southwesterly along said line which separates the City of Willoughby Hills from the City of Wickliffe to its intersection with the centerline of Rockefeller Road;

Thence southeasterly along said centerline of Rockefeller Road to its intersection with the centerline of Eddy Road;

Thence easterly along said centerline of Eddy Road to its intersection with the centerline of Oak Street;

Thence southerly along said centerline of Oak Street to its intersection with the centerline of Chardon Road (U.S. Route No. 6);

Thence westerly along said centerline of Chardon Road to its intersection with the aforesaid centerline of Rockefeller Road;

Thence southerly along said centerline of Rockefeller Road to its intersection with the line which separates the County of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga;

Thence easterly along said line which separates the county of Lake from the County of Cuyahoga to the point of beginning."

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

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SECTION 5. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual operation of a municipal department; to wit: to allow for the City's voting map to be included in the absentee voting ballots as required by the Lake County Board of Elections; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
