ORDINANCE NO. 2008-69

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-17 TO COMPLY WITH STATE BUDGETARY LAWS REQUIRING MUNICIPALITIES TO MAINTAIN POSITIVE ACCOUNT BALANCES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR; REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION AND **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills adopted Ordinance No. 2008-17 on March 27, 2008, for the adoption of permanent appropriations necessary to maintain City services for the fiscal period beginning January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, to comply with the State Budgetary Laws, the City of Willoughby Hills must maintain positive account balances; and

WHEREAS, Council accepts the recommendation of the Finance Director to adopt this Ordinance; thereby the required funds shall be appropriated for the City to be in compliance with the State Budgetary Laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. In order to provide funds for the current expenses of the City and to maintain positive account balances for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2008, the following sums be and hereby are set aside and are to be appropriated as provided hereinafter.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Finance Department and further reason being that it will immediately provide appropriations to meet anticipated City expenses for the period beginning January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
