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ORDINANCE NO. 2008-76

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE CITY VEHICLES AND/OR EQUIPMENT WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF OVER \$1,000 AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mayor Robert M. Weger requested that a 1996 Chevy Blazer 2D, VIN #1GNCT1822TK144247 be declared as surplus property; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 721.15 (A) – Disposition of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property states: “Personal property not needed for municipal purposes, the estimated value of which is less than one thousand dollars, may be sold by the board or officer having supervision or management of that property. If the estimated value of that property is one thousand dollars or more, it shall be sold only when authorized by an ordinance of the legislative authority of the municipal corporation and approved by the board, officer, or director having supervision or management of that property. When so authorized, the board, officer, or director shall make a written contract with the highest and best bidder after advertisement for not less than two or more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation, or with a board of county commissioners upon such lawful terms as are agreed upon, as provided by Division (B) (1) of Section 721.27 of the Ohio Revised Code”.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The following City vehicle with an estimated value of over \$1,000 and plow be and are hereby declared to be surplus property of the City:

1996 Chevy Blazer 2D, VIN #1GNCT1822TK144247, mileage of 118,056

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a written contract with the highest and best bidder for the sale of City property, declared as surplus property, with an estimated value of over \$1,000 after advertisement for not less than two or more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the Municipal Corporation as provided by Section 721.15 (A) of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department to wit: to immediately expedite the sale of said vehicle declared as surplus property by City Ordinance; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
