## **ORDINANCE NO. 2009-18**

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### **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 7 WITH CT CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION-RELATED SERVICES FOR THE EUCLID CREEK TRIBUTARY WATERSHED SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2002-118, as adopted by Council on December 12, 2002 authorized and directed the Mayor to enter into an agreement with CT Consultants, Inc. dated December 13, 2002 for the planning, design, construction administration and inspection of the Euclid Creek Tributary Watershed Sanitary Sewer Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, additional services are required to address changes and additions to the scope of work for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 7 and Exhibit "A" attached hereto identify the engineering services and associated fees related to the Green Ridge Sewer System Evaluation Survey (SSES) Program, possible improper connections at Willoughby Hills Apartments, and to evaluate sewer capacity north of Chardon Road; not previously authorized.


***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:***

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into Contract Amendment No. 7 with CT Consultants, Inc., for additional Professional Engineering Services for the Planning, Design, and Construction-Related Services for the Euclid Creek Tributary Watershed Sanitary Sewer Improvements; not to exceed the total amount of \$53,700.00; and substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in Amendment No. 7 marked as Exhibit "A" consisting of six (6) pages, attached and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department and further provides for the immediate construction of the improvements necessary to improve the water quality in the Euclid Creek Watershed within the construction loan time schedule established by the OEPA to qualify for a low interest loan; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.




