## ORDINANCE NO. 2009-76

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS PROVIDED THROUGH CUSTIS INSURANCE SERVICE INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendation as provided by the Mayor in his Interoffice Memo dated October 5, 2009, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", consisting of (19) pages and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City to accept the proposal for Insurance Coverage as submitted by Custis Insurance Service Inc.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor shall be, and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts as provided through Custis Insurance Service, Inc. for an annual premium or premiums not to exceed **Seventy-Three Thousand, Seven Hundred and Ninety-Three Dollars (\$73,793.00)** substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the proposal, dated September 25, 2009, contained within the Interoffice Memo dated October 5, 2009 provided by the Mayor to Council, consisting of (19) pages attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it further provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department, to wit: the continuance of insurance coverage prior to expiration; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


