ORDINANCE NO. 2009-82

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR LAW DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A JUDGMENT ENTRY RELATING TO ESTATE TAX DISTRIBUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Willoughby Hills to settle a dispute with the City of Painesville relating to estate tax distributions; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the settlement are found within the provisions of the proposed Judgment Entry, In Re: *The Estate of Elizabeth Nina Roemisch, deceased, Case No. 08ES0573*, in the Court of Common Pleas, Division of Probate, Lake County, Ohio on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:


SECTION 1. The Mayor and/or Law Director shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Judgment Entry, In the Matter of: *The Estate of Elizabeth Nina Roemisch, deceased, Case No. 08ES573*, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in said Judgment Entry referenced herein, consisting of two (2) pages, attached hereto as **"Exhibit A"**.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and/or Law Director are authorized and directed on behalf of the City to enter into any and all agreements necessary to execute the provisions set forth by said Judgment Entry.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; to wit: Court mandated that the terms of the Judgment Entry, as agreed upon, were to be executed immediately; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


