AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH V. L. CHAPMAN ELECTRIC, INC. FOR THE CORPORATE 90 & STARK ROAD PUMP STATION REHABILITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2009 the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for the Corporate 90 Stark Drive Pump Station Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2009, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to rebid the Corporate 90 Stark Drive Pump Station Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Corporate 90 & Stark Road Pump Station Rehabilitation on November 6, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the bid from V. L. Chapman Electric, Inc. of Grand River, Ohio for the referenced project has been reviewed and found to be in conformance with all contract requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with V. L. Chapman Electric, Inc. of Grand River, Ohio at a cost not to exceed **\$197,990.00**.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return bid bonds to all unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.




