ORDINANCE NO. 2009 – 91

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF REPUBLIC SERVICES FOR THE CITY-WIDE TRASH AND RECYCLING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on November 2, 2009, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for City-Wide Trash and Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, the bids for the City-Wide Trash and Recycling Program were opened on December 4, 2009 and were reviewed by the Rules and Legislation Committee on December 7, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it was the consensus of the Committee to move forward with the establishment of a City-Wide Trash and Recycling Program by requesting that an Ordinance be prepared to accept the bid as submitted by Republic Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid as submitted by Republic Services of 22730 Fairview Center, #100, Fairview Park, Ohio 44126, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the bid, dated December 4, 2009, for the City-Wide Trash and Recycling Program.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the City's Service Department, and further reason being to allow the City to accept the bid and enter into a contract within 30 days as specified in the bid proposal of Republic Services.; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
