ORDINANCE NO. 2010-29

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BURRIER SERVICE COMPANY, INC. FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A HVAC SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of Willoughby Hills on April 8, 2010, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for a HVAC Replacement System containing boilers/air conditioning for City Hall Complex; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on June 1, 2010 and due to discrepancies in the bidding process, the project was re-bid; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested that legislation be prepared to accept the bid as submitted by Burrier service Company, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid in the amount of One Hundred-Forty-Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$148,250.00) as submitted by Burrier Service Company, Inc., 8669 Twinbrook Drive, P. O. Box 661, Mentor, Ohio 44060, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the bid, opened on June 26, 2010, attached hereto as part of "Exhibit A", consisting of six (6) pages and incorporated herein by reference, for the replacement of a HVAC System for City Hall Complex.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the City Hall Complex, and further reason being to allow the City to accept the bid and enter into a contract within 30 days as specified in the bid proposal of Burrier Service Company, Inc.; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
