## ORDINANCE NO. 2011-22

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**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A 2011 FORD EXPEDITION AT A TOTAL PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$27,298.00 WITH SAID PURCHASE BEING EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.04 (C) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of the Willoughby Hills has accepted the recommendation of the Mayor/Safety Director and the Fire Chief to purchase a 2011 Ford Expedition; and

**WHEREAS**, total price is not to exceed \$27,298.00 with said purchase being obtained through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services/General Services Division/Office of Procurement Services and therefore exempt from Competitive Bidding pursuant to Section 125.04(C) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills approves of the immediate purchase by utilizing funds from # 234 – **Safety Forces Special Revenue Fund**.

***NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:***

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor/Safety Director is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all documents necessary for the procurement of a 2011 Ford Expedition, pursuant to the terms and conditions outlined in the quote provided by Statewide Ford/Lincoln Mercury located at 1108 West Main Street, Van Wert, Ohio 45891, consisting of three (3) pages and marked as Exhibit “A”.


**SECTION 2.** Total price is not to exceed Twenty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred and Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$27,298.00), with said purchase being obtained through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services/General Services Division/Office of Procurement Services and therefore exempt from Competitive Bidding pursuant to Section 125.04 (C) of the Ohio Revised Code.


**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Fire Department; to wit: quote valid for 30 days; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
